AI in Research Reports and Position Papers

The Research Report / Position Paper itself must not be written or formulated in any way by AI. Using AI to check for spelling and grammar mistakes only is allowed.

AI may only be used in order to inform yourself. However, we expect everyone to apply critical thinking when it comes to the use of AI since sources and facts provided are often wrong, out of context or made up. Thus, using AI does not substitute detailed research and we expect everyone to check all mentioned sources.

Keep in mind that all relevant sources must be cited.

AI during the Conference

Speeches, amendments and resolutions are not to be written by AI (Same rules as for Research Reports / Position Papers apply).

If necessary, delegates may conduct further research with the help of AI, though we expect all sources to be checked and critical thinking to be applied.

Consequences for not following this Guideline

Research Reports and Position Papers will be checked and during the conference the Chairs will ensure that AI is not used for any speeches or amendments.

Resolutions and amendments written by AI will not be entertained and Delegates, who still use it, will be disqualified from any awards.

Serious or repeated breaches of this Guideline may also lead to the exclusion from the debate for a certain amount of time.
